NOTICE OF PROPOSED NEW REGULATIONS

In accordance with § 2.1 of the Uniform Administrative Procedure Act, Act No. 38-2017 and Art. 3 of the University of Puerto Rico Act, Act No. 1 of January 20, 1966, as amended, the Governing Board of the University of Puerto Rico notifies that it proposes to approve:

- (1) the new *Student Regulations of the University of Puerto Rico Humacao Campus*, with the purpose of establishing the rights and duties that correspond to the students of the campus, in accordance with the Law of the UPR, as well as complementary norms to the University of Puerto Rico General Student Regulations. The proposed regulation provides for student participation structures, student organizations, electoral processes, and student disciplinary norms and processes, among other matters.
- (2) a new *University of Puerto Rico Travel Expense Regulations*, with the purpose of establishing the norms, processes and controls that will govern the travel expenses incurred by officials, employees, individuals and students authorized to travel in or out of Puerto Rico to carry out official assignments on behalf of the University of Puerto Rico, among other matters.
- (3) and an *University of Puerto Rico Institutional Protocol for the Prevention and Proper Management of Situations of Domestic Violence in the Workplace*, with the purpose of providing uniformity to the measures and processes to be followed by the University when one of its employees is subjected to domestic violence and to facilitate the implementation of preventive and security measures to handle cases that may endanger the work environment, among other matters.

During a period of thirty (30) calendar days from the publication of this Notice, persons interested in submitting comments or submitting a request for an oral hearing on the proposed actions must do so in writing, in any of the following ways: (a) presenting your written comments personally at the office of the Governing Board, at the physical address indicated above at 8:00 am at 4:30 p.m. from Monday to Friday; (b) sending your letter by postal mail to PO Box 23326, San Juan, PR 00931-3326; or (c) sending an email to comentario.RG@upr.edu. Every request for an oral hearing must include the specific grounds that, in the opinion of the applicant, makes necessary to grant it.
